

MAILBOX STANDARDS FOR FOUNTAIN LAKES RESOLUTION

A resolution by the Board of Governors for the Fountain Lakes Community Association, Inc.
Mailbox Standards for Fountain Lakes Resolution

WHEREAS, the Board of Governors of the Fountain Lakes Community Association has reviewed the community need for consistency and quality and has discussed the history and previously established requirements for mailbox replacement as specified and published on the Community Television Channel and Website, the Board hereby officially establishes the requirements and standards for mailboxes throughout the entire Fountain Lakes Community. All mail boxes must comply with the standards set forth in this resolution and must be like or similar to current mail boxes in the community. Mailboxes must have a white cross post design, with white rural style mailbox approximately 18Lx9Hx7w, and installed at the United States Postal Service required height of 41-45 inches from the road surface. Posts and other members may be made of wood or plastic and have caps or no caps. Diagonal supports if used may be of the straight or scrolled design. The Board recognizes that Postal Regulations for apartments and multi-family condominium may deviate from this design and must meet the requirements set forth by the USPS, where the aforementioned Community Standards will not apply. The Board in keeping with powers conveyed in the covenants and bylaws of the Association retains all rights to compel compliance with these standards.
