- 1. CANDIDATE INTENT TO RUN FORMS NOW DUE BY MARCH 7, 2025*** IF YOU ALREADY SUBMITTED YOUR INTENT THERE IS NO NEED TO RESUBMIT
- 2. FIRST NOTICE OF ELECTION (AT LEAST 60 DAYS BEFORE THE ELECTION)NEW FIRST NOTICE DATE IS NOW FEBRUARY 15, 2025 THIS WAS NOT DONE
 ON JANUARY 20TH DUE TO CLERICAL ERROR RESULTING IN A DELAY OF OUR
 ANNUAL MEETING AND ELECTIONS. IF YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED THIS BY
 FEBRUARY 28, PLEASE CONTACT PEGASUS TO ENSURE THEY HAVE YOUR
 CORRECT MAILING ADDRESS ON FILE.
- 3. CANDIDATE FORUM OR DEBATE -THIS IS OPTIONAL AND WAS DISCUSSED BY THE MASTER BOARD BUT NO DECISION HAS BEEN MADE.
- 4. SECOND NOTICE OF ELECTION AND BALLOT/PROXY (14-34 DAYS BEFORE THE ELECTION) NOW WILL BE MAILED ON MARCH 12, 2025
- 5. CASTING OF VOTES -"SEE BELOW VOTING OPTIONS"
- 6. ANNUAL MEETING/ELECTIONS & VOTE COUNTING- APRIL 16, 2025
- 7. ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESULTS-APRIL 16, 2025

On March 12th, management will mail out information sheets and ballot materials to all residents at the address on file. For part-time residents, this may be your summer address. If you haven't received your packet or it was sent to your summer address, please visit the office where a new packet will be available for you.

VOTING OPTIONS

Proxy Voting; Complete a proxy form to allow a designated person to vote on your behalf at the annual meeting. It is advisable and requested that proxy designation be done as early as possible so management can determine participation to establish a quorum for the meeting. This can be done by dropping off your proxy or mailing to the office.

In-Person or Early Drop-Off Voting: Submit your ballot that you received in the mail to the office or mail to Pegasus anytime after receiving the second notice of March 12th, 2025. ***BE SURE TO SIGN YOUR BALLOT ENVELOPE AND INCLUDE YOUR ADDRESS for without that information your vote will not be counted**** IF YOU DID NOT RECEIVE SECOND NOTICE AND BALLOT IN THE MAIL THEY ARE AVAILABLE AT THE OFFICE.

"RESIDENT SPOTLIGHT" JANET HILDEBRAND'S 1000 MILE ADVENTURE ON THE APPALACHIAN TRAIL

Have you ever dreamed of hiking the Appalachian Trail? Spanning over 2,178 miles from Georgia to Maine, it's an adventure that challenges even the most seasoned hikers. But for Fountain Lakes resident Janet Hildebrand, this daunting journey became a personal mission—a testament to perseverance, grit, and a love for nature.

Janet's journey began in 2008, with a goal to hike the trail in segments, ultimately reaching 1,000 miles to Harpers Ferry Historical Park in West Virginia. Over the years, she spent countless hours hiking alone, sleeping under the stars in her tent, and surviving on a humble diet of ramen noodles, oatmeal, and tuna, all prepared using the gear she carried in her pack.

Her husband, Mike, was her support system, driving her to trailheads and exploring nearby towns while she hiked. Whenever possible, they would meet up for dinner before Janet returned to the trail for a night in her tent.

The journey wasn't just about endurance—it was also about the beauty and wonder of the trail. Janet encountered wild ponies, stunning wildflowers, and other natural marvels that made each mile unforgettable.

But the trail wasn't without its challenges. In her eighth year, Janet suffered a serious fall, breaking her leg and arm. Alone and injured, she managed to call a shuttle driver, who came to her rescue and rushed her to the hospital. For most people, this would have been the end of the adventure. But not for Janet.

In year nine, at the age of 73, Janet returned to the trail to finish what she started. She hiked over 200 miles to Harpers Ferry, completing her remarkable journey with the same determination that carried her through every mile.

Janet's story is an inspiration to us all—a reminder that age, setbacks, and challenges are no match for perseverance and passion. Congratulations, Janet, on your incredible achievement!
