# President's Notes

The Fountain Lakes Master Annual meeting was held on March 18, 2022. A request on the proxy asked that our residents vote whether to allow the Master Board to Convey ten feet of Association Property (retention pond on Williams Road) to the Village of Estero for the purpose of the Williams Road project, assuming the Board of Directors is able to negotiate agreeable terms with the Village of Estero. We received 395 proxies out of the 900 owners in Fountain Lakes. The Board moved to reconvene the vote at the April 20th, 2022 Board Meeting held in the Activity Center at 6 PM. There will not be a mailing but the information will be posted 14 days prior to the meeting.

# "COVENANT COACHING"

for the benefit of our newer residents and a refresher for those folks who have been busy with life in "Paradise" and may appreciate a reminder. Fountain Lakes has always been a deed-restricted community. Abiding by the Covenants protects the value of our property and the integrity of our neighborhoods.

Violations to the Fountain Lakes Covenant and Bylaws and Rules and Regulations may result in a Fine if the situation is not resolved in a timely manner.

A copy of the recorded 2020 Covenants, Bylaws, and Recorded Rules and Regulations for Fountain Lakes Community Association, Inc. was mailed to each owner-of-record during April of 2020. New owners should have received a copy when they purchased their home. You may also find them on the Fountain Lakes Website - https://fountainlakesestero.com/

### Amended and Restated Declaration 2020

8.1 <u>Fines and Suspensions</u>. The Board of Directors may levy fines and/or suspensions against members, or members' tenants or guests, or both, who commit violations of Chapters 617 or 720, Florida Statutes, the provisions of the governing documents, or the rules and regulations, or who condone such violations by their family members, guests or lessees. Fines shall be in amounts deemed necessary by the Board to deter future violations, but in no event shall any single fine exceed \$200.00 per violation per day with each day of the same violation constituting a continuing violation allowing another fine of up to \$200.00. The maximum fine for a continuing violation shall be \$5,000.00. As allowed by law fines shall be secured by a lien on the Owner's Lot. Suspensions of the use of Common Areas, facilities and common non-essential services may be imposed for a reasonable period of time to deter future violations. The procedure for imposing fines or suspending use rights shall be as follows: 8.2 Notice.

8.3 <u>Hearing</u>.

8.4 <u>Correction of Health and Safety Hazards</u>. Any violations of the Association rules which creates conditions of the property which are deemed by the Board of Directors to be a hazard to the public health or safety may be dealt with immediately as an emergency matter by the Association, and the cost thereof shall be charged to the Lot Owner.

# Lane Dividers for the Front Entrance

Many residents have commented about vehicles switching lanes and tailgating to enter the front gate. The Master Association had the lane dividers installed as a first step to slow down the issues. The next step is to install drop-down gates to prevent tailgating.

Food for Thought!

Fruit trees are popular, especially with the Florida climate. We need to remember that the fruit that falls on the ground will attract a variety of wildlife. Be sure to clean up fallen fruit. The wild hogs from the vacant property on the west side of Fountain Lakes roamed around the Seabreeze neighborhood and were very destructive in the process.

## Mating Season for Alligators

The warm weather of springs usually means the alligators are more active and visible. Courtship starts in April with mating taking place in May or June usually in open water. In late June and early July, the mother alligator lays about 35 eggs in a nest made of mud, sticks, and other plant matter. The nests are usually about three feet tall and six feet in diameter, located in swampy areas. Stay safe and keep your distance from Alligators.

You would think our pleasant gated community would be free from crime, but unfortunately, it is not. Fountain Lakes residents, who have security cameras, have view people trying to gain entrance to vehicles. Never leave your billfold, purse, or keys in your vehicle.
