The Village of Estero Zoning PLANNING ZONING AND DESIGN BOARD meeting was held on November 8TH, 2022. The Marketplace Development Order (District 6) (DOS2022-E001) 8001 Via Rapallo Drive, located east of US 41, north of Sweetwater Ranch Blvd., and south of Via Rapallo Dr. was on the agenda.

This Development Order is for the construction of a mixed-use commercial development, consisting of five buildings with parking, landscaping, and stormwater management.

The site is across the road from Fountain Lakes and Coconut Point Ford. Will it impact Fountain Lake? I am sure it will but not sure just how. We may get the Stop light at our intersection Which we have wanted for many years.

Covenant Coaching

"Covenant Coaching" for the benefit of our newer residents and a refresher for those folks who have been busy with life in "Paradise" and may appreciate a reminder. Fountain Lakes has always been a deed-restricted community. Abiding by the Convenances protects the value of our property and the integrity of our neighborhoods.

Please note the Amended and Restated Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions:

"Committed Property" homeowners' property.

"Corporate Common Property" Association property such as roads, Cul-de-Sac, and clubhouse area.

A reminder: An Architectural Review Forms (ARC) are required for any external addition, change/modification including paint colors, landscaping changes, pools and enclosure expansions, expansions of lanais, external changes to the residence, antennas/satellite dishes, fences, permanent constructed firepits, altering driveway size or material, Flag Poles, Gardens, Lighting, or outdoor Equipment. Loss of Habitat and Invasion of Hogs

For many years, the land west of Fountain Lakes property has NOT been maintained and has been a home for many wild animals. It has always been private property and NOT a preserve. This land is now being cleared for the new Raptor Bay Golf. Raptor Bay is within Bonita Springs Boundary lines. The loss of habitat has caused the animals to roam further from their normal space.

We continue to have the hogs trapped because of their destruction of resident's property. We have now caught 15 hogs and the next date to hunt is Nov 21st. and will continue to track until they believe they have eliminated the problem.

Florida Fish and Wildlife stated homeowners have the right to remove the hogs. Some residents have placed spotlights and played music in their yards at night which has deterred the hogs from entering their property. The Humble Tortoise:

Aesop's Fable tells the story of the tortoise who beat the hare with its slow and methodical determination. Fountain Lakes has its own colony of Gopher Tortoises. The mound they call home is located on Sand Dune Lane. In the past, the mound has been allowed to grow wild and has become unsightly. Upon research with Florida Fish and Wildlife, it was discovered the proper way to maintain the Tortoise Mound. Please do NOT feed the Tortoise... human food draws other animals to the food and can disrupt the Tortoise.

Routine vegetation maintenance, vegetation removal, and landscaping near tortoise burrows do not require a permit or relocation of gopher tortoises, FWC does recommend taking steps to minimize or avoid disturbance to gopher tortoise burrows. Here are a few steps we recommend taking:

- 1. Set mower blades as high as possible to avoid injuring small tortoises which may be difficult to see in taller vegetation.
- 2. If you are using a heavy sit-on-top lawn mower, avoid mowing near the mouth of the burrow by approximately 10-15 ft in all directions. If you wish to trim the vegetation closer to the mouth of a burrow, we recommend using a weed whacker.
- 3. Use flagging tape and/or wooden stakes to mark locations of known burrows. Flagging burrows will help create visual awareness so that you can better avoid the burrows.
- 4. If you are mowing a smaller area, we recommend briefly scanning the area on foot in case small tortoises are actively foraging.
- 5. If you are using herbicide to control invasive plant species, we recommend direct application rather than broadcast application.
