Notes from Fountain Lakes Master Association President

The Fountain Lakes Community Association is responsible for maintaining standards of appearance, safety, and the values of our neighborhood. The board must plan for future repairs, replacements, expenses, legal fees, etc. that may arise from managing the community. It has been determined the 2024 Master budget will impose an increase of \$70.00 per quarter in the HOA fees paid to Fountain Lakes Master association.

We are being faced with many increases due to inflation, raising costs for outside contractual work required for maintaining our community, needed repairs due to the age of our community, cleanup from hurricane Ian in 2022, and the expenses brought on by the Abbiati Dental Development which include expenses for legal fees, traffic studies, engineering reports and survey. Many of you are aware that Fountain Lakes has been sued by Abbiati Dental and we will continue to work in the best interest of our residents through this process.

Our reserve budget has been hit with unplanned expenses due to seawall and sinkhole repairs. The 2024 budget will include an increase to what is being funded to our reserves. We have also budgeted for a reserve study to be done. The study will give us a physical and financial analysis of the association's assets so that we will be able to project a financial road map for the association going into the future.

Residents need to be aware that the individual neighborhoods may have budget increases above the Master Budget increases.
