## UPDATE - Temporary Fences on residential property within Fountain Lakes

The Fountain Lakes Master Declarants do NOT prohibit fences in the community. The Fountain Lakes Recorded Rules and Regulation do have restrictions on the style of fence allowed. Fountain Lakes Community Association Board has the ability to make a rule change without a vote of the community.

**SOME** sub-associations do have restrictions prohibiting fences. To allow temporary fences in those neighborhoods would require each neighborhood to modify its declarants. They need to send out notification of the change with a proxy and receive a majority of the resident's permission. If it is approved, that respective sub-association would have limited ability to restrict any fences and moving forward would therefore have to vote no fencing back into the declarants. In other words, there is no "temporary special exception" due to extenuating circumstances such as the invasive hog problem.

Alternatives to temporary fences are: Motion activated sprinklers, Motion activated sonar light devices, motion-activated flood lights, air horns, spraying a hog (if seen) with a garden hose, and also bear spray seem to work well according to Florida Fish and Wildlife. Some residents have had some success with spreading crushed red pepper in their yards. I have also had luck with planting cayenne plants – they are very quick to grow and can be placed intermittently throughout your yard.
