The judge ordered Fountain Lakes and Abbiati to participate in Mediation in order to come to an agreement regarding Fountain Lakes Blvd modification. The mediation is currently scheduled for February 7th.

The FLCA Board of Governors addressed several issues regarding the Abbiati Project at the January BOG meeting. Covenant Coaching

For the benefit of our newer residents and a refresher for those folks who have been busy with life in "Paradise" and may appreciate a reminder. Fountain Lakes has always been a deed restricted community. Abiding by the Convenances protects the value of our property and the integrity of our neighborhoods.

Amended and Restated Declaration 2020 - An owner has the right to rent their residence but, there are restrictions. 4.26 <u>Dwelling Units; Residential Use.</u>

All single-family homes can only be leased or rented to single families, and that all lessees must provide proof of family relationship and that all lessees have read and will abide by the Community Association Covenants and Restrictions. Furthermore, all lessees shall register with the Neighborhood HOA or COA, and provide current contact information. It is also agreed that no single-family home shall be rented for a term of less than 30 days and each unit shall be rented no more than four times in a single calendar year.

Be aware, some neighborhoods have stricter rental regulations. Their documents might say not less than 3 months or not less than 6 months and only 2 times per year. Contact Ashley Wamble at Ashley W@pegasuscam.com for the rental agreement.

Every Person who purchases a home in Fountain Lakes is given a copy of the Fountain Lakes Documents at the time of closing. Way Back When...

Fountain Lakes was originally called Estero Woods? At that time, it only consisted of the apartment buildings. Kraus-Anderson was the developer

and in Aug of 1987 he filed the Fountain Lakes Protective Covenants and Restriction. The first single family house was built in 1988. It was not until March 13 of 2001 that the residents of Fountain Lakes took over the Fountain Lakes Community Association. The first officers of the Fountain Lakes Community Association Board of Governors were; Ken Wisen, Tom McKeever, Joe Putzback, Alice Walat, and David Pryal.

Here we are, beginning the year 2024. There have been many changes in the 37 years since Fountain Lakes began. We use the term "door" to indicate how many households are in the Fountain Lakes Community. We have 900 "doors" that consist of Apartments, Villas, Condos, and Single-Family homes. We still have some of the original owners living in Fountain Lakes.
