Ever wonder who helps keep our community looking cohesive and welcoming? That's our Architectural Review Committee (ARC)! Guided by Florida Statute §720.3035, the ARC reviews exterior changes—like new fences, paint colors, or landscaping—to ensure they match our HOA's vision, as outlined in our governing documents (CC&Rs). The ARC is all about protecting what makes your neighborhood special. It keeps our homes looking harmonious, which boosts curb appeal and property values for everyone. By ensuring changes meet local codes and our community standards, the ARC prevents headaches and keeps disputes to a minimum. ARC does its best to be open and transparent—meetings are open to the public, decisions are clear, and responses comes within 45 days after receiving sub-association approval. Before you start that exterior project, reach out to your sub-association HOA/COA board for guidance and approval. They are your first step and will help you navigate the ARC process.
