

Letter from Ed Schreiner our President:

First of all, welcome back to "Season". For those of us who live here year round, the electicity in the air (and the traffic) are the indication that we are entering another active year. For those of you returning for the season, Welcome Back!

By the time you read this, I'm hoping that the Nov 4 election results in the new Estero Village that we've been hearing about for the past months. Regardless, Estero is, in my view, an excellent place to live and it is my fervent hope that the future continues to be as promising.

Here in Fountain Lakes, we've also been busy over the summer.

We have implemented a new data base and key entry system for the gates. We worked very hard to communicate to everyone the need to re-register your clickers and keypad codes. We've been asked many times why we had to do it. The fact is, the old data base was maxed out. We could no longer add anyone to the system and we have sufficient churn in ownership and rentals that we are constantly having to add people. The new data base gives us ample room to add people as we go forward. We are also making a concerted effort to delete people who move out so that we have less of a problem of proliferation of clickers. At this point, we have gotten the vast majority of people moved over to the new system. But, if you've been gone for awhile, I strongly recommend that you come to the office with your clicker(s) to make sure we have you in the new system so you can come in after hours. It takes no more than 5 minutes for us to check for you.

The other issue we are addressing is the rear (Williams Road) gate. We've had too many instances of people crashing the gate and causing damage that costs us money. We are working on a new design that will be much more difficult to crash and, therefore, more secure. We're putting the finishing touches on the plan now and hope to have that addressed before year-end. We also are aware that Garmin and other GPS devices direct people to that gate instead of the US41 gate. I have been in touch with the data base company that the GPS companies use and the process of changing that is not a simple process, but we are working to see if we can get that accomplished.

I'm sure it's not lost on anyone that we have installed speed humps throughout the community. We have tried sheriff's patrols to discourage the speeding and stop-sign running that has been rampant in our community but, despite approximately 15 tickets being issued, there was little improvement in the behavior of certain individuals who apparently believe that the stop signs and speed limit signs do not apply to them. We've had numerous instances of people coming dangerously close to being hit by speeders and stop sign runners and we have too many people who walk and ride their bikes in this community to allow that behavior to continue. We will also continue to bring in sheriff's patrols periodically until we are successful in bringing some order to the traffic on our streets. For those of us in the majority who do obey the signs, I ask your forbearance and understanding. The Board is making every effort with all these projects to make Fountain Lakes a safe, secure place for each of us to live.
