Important Notice About

» Reserve funding for certain common element items is required for community associations under Florida law. Specifically, associations fund reserves for roof replacement of common owned buildings, building painting, pavement resurfacing, pool resurfacing, gates and any other item that has a maintenance expense or replacement cost exceeding \$10,000.

» Florida law allows for two types of reserve funding, one of which is the pooled method (also referred to as the "cash flow" method) and the other is the component method (also referred to as the "straight-line" method).

» The biggest advantage to a pooled account is the flexibility that comes with how the reserve funds are spent. Funds can be drawn from the pooled account to cover expenses for any of the reserve assets at any time. Thus, the pooling method provides significantly more flexibility than component reserve accounts and allows for projects to be completed, in order of need, at the time the need arises, possibly eliminating the need for a Special Assessment when funds in one category may be short at the time of the unexpected expenditure. Member approval is required to use the pooled funds to pay for any item not included within the reserve pool.

» Because there is a current shortfall in some categories, if the owners in Fountain Lakes do NOT vote to move to Pooled Reserves, by law the board should do a Special Assessment of the owners for that shortfall.

» The Board of Directors is asking owners to please vote IN FAVOR of Pooled Reserves for Fountain Lakes Community Association.

Always Improving

Inexpensive Easy Scanner

Scanning is so useful these days because scanning and emailing, or scanning and saving, saves you money as you are not printing, which uses printer ink and paper. Scanning produces a clear image of text rather than using the camera on your phone which does not create images that are very clear of text.

There is a fabulous scanner you can get on the App Store for use with your iphones or ipads, and any other smart phone that can use apps from the App Store. For one low price, you can share this scanner with everyone you share your itunes account with. I use this scanner to scan recipes from magazines and articles that I wish to keep.

The price can vary a bit from one day to the next, but it usually costs between \$3.00- \$7.00, or it is in a suite of three apps for about \$12-\$17.00. Look on the App Store for Scanner Pro and it is sold by Readdle.

We use ScannerPro for all our scanning now and never use our big scanner anymore, because this scanner is so easy and convenient.

Don't mistake the difference between taking a picture with your phone which produces a JPEG or using a scanner with your phone, which produces a PDF. If you are making a copy of a document with printed words a JPEG is not very effective, and a PDF is a better choice. The correct usage of a picture with your phone is for another picture. For printed documents it is best to use a scanner, so you get a clear copy of the print.

Using just my iphone I can scan full sized documents, over 20 pages long, and email them directly as one PDF to anyone I want, or save them to my documents on my computer. It is so easy and handy to scan and save documents or scan and email documents to your accountant or lawyer or anyone who needs to receive a document from you

If you do buy ScannerPro and would like a quick lesson, I could provide that for you. It would take you about 2 minutes to learn to use it. It takes only two steps.
