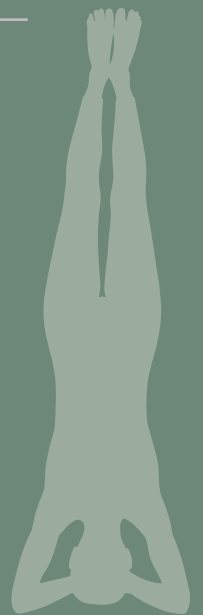

## *"Covenant Coaching"*

This monthly article is for the benefit of our newer residents and a refresher for those folks who have been busy with life in "Paradise" and may appreciate a reminder. Fountain Lakes has always been a deed restricted community. Abiding by the Convenances protects the value of our property and the integrity of our neighborhoods.

**Hurricane Preparation:** Residents need to prepare for the Hurricane Season, especially if you are returning to your northern home for the summer and fall. We ask that you abide by the Fountain Lakes Recorded rules and regulations.

### **RECORDED RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR FOUNTAIN LAKES COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC**

6. Hurricane Shutters
  - a. May be installed from June 1 to November 30 on the back or side of the house.
  - b. Front shutters can only be used or installed 72 hours in advance of a hurricane and must be removed within 72 hours after the hurricane has passed.
  - c. Owners who plan to be gone during hurricane season (June 1- November 30th) shall be responsible for preparing their residence for hurricanes by removing all furniture, potted plants and other movable objects from their yard, and arranging for a designated person or firm to install hurricane shutters no more than 72 hours before a hurricane and remove them no later than 72 hours following the hurricane.

## *Lake Bank Restoration*

Fountain Lakes Master Association has a plan to restore a section of our lakes banks every year. We accepted a proposal from Copeland Southern Enterprises, Inc. for the Lake # 2 Phase 2 Drainage & Lake Bank Restoration. It is recommended to do this project during the dry season when the water is at its lowest so Material from the lake bottom can be recovered. The project was planned started end of April.

They will Rebuild and Reinforce Lake 2's (Large Lake) north slope with layered Coconut Erosion Blanket totaling over 550 feet with reclaimed material from Lake 2 bottom. All guest and residents will need to stay clear of the equipment during the project. All sprinkler heads within the work area must be clearly marked by Landscaper Crews before work begins.

This year's project encompasses the bank behind 22702, 22703, 22709, and 22715 on Island Lakes Blvd and 22693 Forest Ridge Shores.

***We have learned that The City of Estero now requires a permit and possibly an engineering study to maintain the lake banks. This was not a requirement in past years. At the point in time, we are not sure what is involved in getting the permit or the cost of study. Hopefully, we will be able move forward with the project.***

Bocce Ball sign up for the 2022 season is on the bulletin board by the Billiards Room.

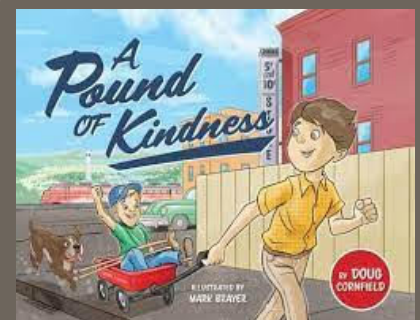

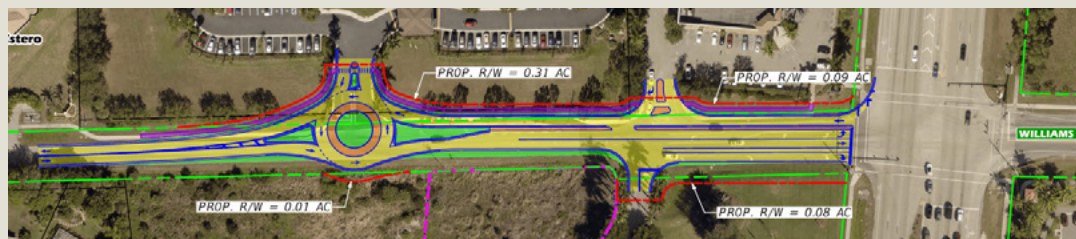

# RESOLUTION NO. 2021-12 – WILLIAMS ROAD/ATLANTIC GULF BLVD INTERSECTION

The Village of Estero Council adopted this resolution approving a budget amendment for the use of additional Village funds for Williams Road and Atlantic Gulf Blvd intersection improvements to improve the safety and traffic flow along Williams Road west of US 41.

Council previously approved a concept design which includes closing the left turn out of Walgreens, extending the left turn lane at US 41 and installing a roundabout at the Estero Life Care Center entrance.

The Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Budget includes \$300,000 for the Williams Road and Atlantic Gulf Blvd. intersection improvements. It is estimated the project will cost approximately \$575,500, requiring approximately \$275,500 of additional funds. This includes project design, permitting and project management cost, plus a 10% contingency.
